

Our measures to reduce gas consumption



1.



Radiator thermostats

Manually adjustable thermostats should be set to a level of 2–3 during the day. A setting of level 2 is recommended.

2.



Offices

In offices, manually adjustable radiator thermostats should be set to level 1 before leaving at the end of a working day.

3.



Air exchange

To ensure room ventilation in offices and teaching rooms the windows should be opened wide for five minutes. Tilting the windows is prohibited.

4.



Heaters and mobile radiators

The use of mobile radiators and heaters (e.g. electric fan heaters) is prohibited.

5.



Doors

All doors should be closed during the heating period.

6.



Lighting and equipment

The lights and all presentation equipment should be switched off when leaving the office or teaching rooms. This is the responsibility of the teaching staff.

7.



Stand-by-Mode

Electrical devices have to be switched off completely – if possible – after use. (e.g. monitors). Stand-by-mode is prohibited.
