Applicants of Deutschlandstipendium (Germany Scholarship)

You are interested in applying for a Deutschlandstipendium from the Nordhausen University of Applied Sciences?

The objective of this scholarship program is to support and promote highly-talented students who can be expected to demonstrate or who have already demonstrated outstanding performance in their studies and professional activity.

Over the past years, numerous students at the Nordhausen University have been supported and promoted through the Deutschlandstipendium program, and we have received highly positive feedback from them.

We are looking forward to receiving your application!

The scholarships in the Deutschlandstipendium program at Nordhausen University are announced and awarded only once a year.

The application period for the 2023/24 scholarship cycle ends on 30. June 2023. We have to award 8 scholarships. Five of these scholarships are reserved for students of technical programmes. Please send the application via E-mail (contact person see below).

Who may receive a scholarship?

Scholarships may be awarded to students who

- are enrolled as a student at the Nordhausen University or
- will be enrolled as a student at the time of the next funding/scholarship period, and
- credibly show that from their background and previous performance, extraordinary academic performance and achievements can be expected during their studies.

Scholarships will not be awarded to students who

- receive another talent or performance-based scholarship or funding from a German or foreign institution if this scholarship or funding amounts to € 30 per month or more.

How to apply?

Applications

- can only be sent per E-Mail

The application to be submitted must include the following documents:

- Letter of motivation (max. 2 pages);
- Curriculum vitae in tabular form;
- if applicable, proof of other skills and competencies and/or voluntary/social work or commitment at the Nordhausen University.
- if applicable, proof or explanation of special social, family, or personal circumstances.

Note: If the certificate was issued outside of Germany, in addition, a German or English translation.

What is the amount of the scholarship?

The scholarship amounts to € 300 per month, paid as non-repayable grant irrespective of your income, and is, in general, initially granted for the duration of one year (2 Semesters).

The period of sponsorship/funding always begins with the winter semester (in October).

Who makes the selection of applicants?

Based on the submitted supporting documents, scholarships are awarded by the responsible selection committee. Members of this committee are:

- President of the Nordhausen University of Applied Sciences,
- Professors of the Nordhausen University of Applied Sciences,
- Employees of the Nordhausen University of Applied Sciences,
- Scholarship holder from the last year.

After the scholarship has been awarded...

When accepting the scholarship, scholarship holders automatically commit to

- immediately informing the responsible persons (see below) of all changes that may have consequences for the scholarship, these include, but are not limited to,
- if the scholarship holder intends to change the study program or the university;
- if the scholarship holder will not be able to successfully complete the chosen study program in the standard duration of the study;
- if the scholarship holder intends to interrupt or discontinue his or her studies;

Note: It is also possible to re-apply for a new scholarship.
