Specific educational sensorial needs: The case of students with hearing impairment

Content:

This subject is part of an Inclusive Education subject dealing with:

- Anatomy and physiology of the ear.
- Detection and diagnosis.
- Technical aids.
- Impact of deafness on the family environment
- Orientations to the family
- Communication modes for people with deafness
- The acquisition of oral language.
- Speech therapy intervention for the oral language development of students with deafness.
- Modalities of schooling of students with deafness
- Orientations at school.
- Educational services in Catalonia: the CREDA.

Methods:

The methodology consists of guided classes and practical seminars where the explanations are combined with readings and comments, analysis of audiovisual material, etc.

Competences and skills to be acquired:

- Design and regulate learning spaces in contexts of diversity.
- Design, plan and evaluate education and learning processes, both individually and in collaboration with other - teachers and professionals at the centre.
- Develop autonomous learning strategies.
- Develop the skill of tutoring and guidance of pupils and their families, attending to the pupils own needs.
- Recognise and evaluate the social reality and the interrelation of factors involved as a necessary.
- Recognise and evaluate the social reality and the interrelation of factors involved as a necessary anticipation of action.
- Respect the diversity and the plurality of ideas, people and situations.
- Work in teams and with teams.

Prerequisites:

It is not necessary for students to have acquired knowledge related to the anatomy and physiology of the ear as well as the pathology of the hearing. Students should be motivated to know the reality of people with hearing impairment and the possibilities that their environment offers them.
